What is Social Prescribing?

Social prescribing is a method of linking you to non-medical support within your community. The intention is to help to improve your social, mental and physical wellbeing.

How could it help you?

This could help you to:

- Feel less lonely and isolated
- Manage your long term health conditions better
- Feel more confident and less stressed
- Take control of your own health and wellbeing
- Reach support to stop smoking or cut down alcohol consumption
- Obtain support for housing difficulties
- Link up with local community activity groups



A Social Prescriber

is someone you can talk to confidentially and

- Is practical, helpful and will not judge you
- Can help you decide 'what matters to me' to improve your health, wellbeing and independence
- Can find activities that will suit you, and is someone who Can give you
 support along the way.

How can I get an appointment?

Anyone can use this service free of charge. Ask a Health Professional or a member of your GP surgery team to refer you. You can also self-refer. Your Social Prescribing Link Worker will then contact you to make an appointment.
